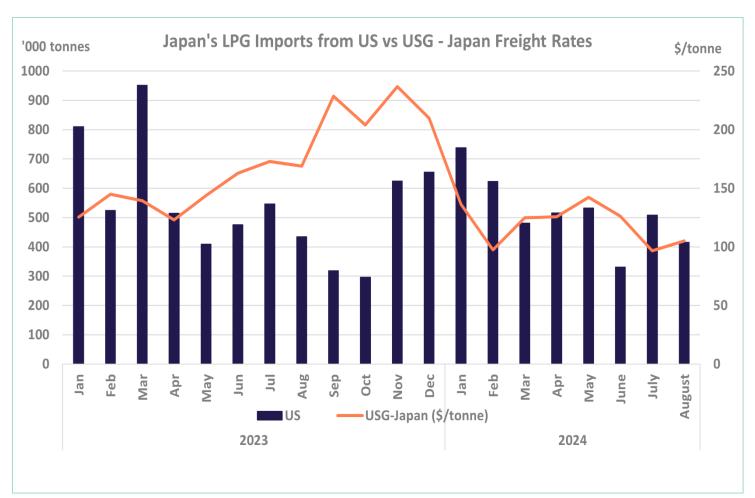


RLA Weekly LPG Report – Wednesday, 16 October 2024

Japan's LPG Imports from US vs USG - Japan Freight Rates

- In August 2024, Japan imported 416,000 tonnes of LPG from the U.S., representing an 18% decrease from July's total of 508,000 tonnes. During the first eight months of 2024, U.S. LPG exports to Japan amounted to 4.1 million tonnes, indicating a 4.0% decline compared to the same period in 2023. The decline was driven by weaker petrochemical demand and Japan's transition towards LNG, leading to an overall decrease in LPG imports.
- Despite the lower import volumes, freight rates on the U.S. Gulf to Japan route saw some recovery.
 Rates began the month at \$90/tonne and rose to \$118.6/tonne by the end of August, with an average
 of \$105/tonne. This rate increase was primarily fuelled by supply chain dynamics, including backlogs
 at U.S. terminals that led to additional cargo movements. These logistical factors kept freight rates
 elevated, even as overall demand for LPG in Japan remained sluggish.
